

Individual rights belonged only to males, the rich and those with power. Support – Christianity.


#### Renaissance

# REPRODUCTIVE RESPONSIBILITIES

- Binding responsibilities to the resulting child;
- This also results in a corollary responsibility of the child towards the parents;
- 3. Establishment of family relationships



Reproductive rights includes the right of married couples to decide on matters relating to procreating which includes use of technology involving their reproductive organs and its functions.

# WHAT IS AN INNOVATION?

- Innovate bring in novelties; make changes in something that was already established
- Law through legislation creates rights that can be enforced.
  - Law instructs officials of the state to act in a particular way
    - The Legislation in itself was an instrument of colonisers.
- Innovation in law making the task of rendering legal ideas as comprehensibly and clearly as possible
- However in the realm of law making encouraging innovation for its own sake is pointless and is dangerous
- Innovation in law making is to address particular difficulties as they rise.

HARM TO OTHERS PRINCIPLE

ALLOWS LIMITS TO INDIVIDUAL LIBERTY ONLY WHEN HARM TO OTHERS IS ESTABLISHED

TO LIMIT THE USE OF A.R.T TO MARRIED COUPLES COULD BE DEEMED AS AN ENCROACHMENT ON THE RIGHTS OF INDIVIDUALS

No legislation – respects autonomy of the infertile couples ONLY

#### **RESULTS**

Reproductive rights is not an absolute right. The state can and should limit the right in order to protect the responsibilities owed to the resulting child.





Through respect and recognition of not only reproductive rights of couples BUT also the responsibilities owed to the resulting children








# THE SHARI'AH POSITION


