



IIIT has been a leader in publishing intellectual works on Maqasid al-Shari'ah, especially in the English language. Much conceptual work has been done over the last two decades, including works on the maqasid literature of our past scholars. Researchers are strongly encouraged to utilise these IIIT publications, most of them downloadable without any charge. There is an increasing need to apply these Maqasid al-shari'ah frameworks to different areas of study, to be cross or inter-disciplinary in nature, as well as works that can lead to policy prescriptions.

This SRP grant hopes to encourage more focused research to include developing Maqasid Frameworks for Policy Makers; Applied Maqasid Studies (in domains such as Sustainable Development, Economics, Health, Education, Law, Sciences among others) with policy implications (pro-active framework).

All grant applications will be reviewed by a IIIT panel. All application forms must be completed and supported by the necessary documents. Short-listed candidates may be asked to attend a 'pre-research' briefing to ensure that the research is completed within the stipulated time.
