- Western literature and media coverage on the word Diaspora

Internal Factor

- Sectarian violence
- Oppressive Regime
- Racism
- Genocide
- Absence of good governance, etc.

External Factors

- Intrusion of a foreign army
- Intimidation of war by a neighbouring country
- Annexation of a country by its neighbouring country, etc.

Diasporic Muslims in the West

- Don't bite the hands that feed you
- Follow the law of the land of the host country
- Don't try to change people in the West overnight
- Support people in the host country on all that are good for humanity, so long they are not detrimental to their Islamic faith and ethics
- Active participation in interfaith dialogues
- Do not isolate themselves from the larger population, etc.

How to Stop the Diaspora (Muslim World)

- Stop war, sectarian violence, extremism
- Bring back good governance
- Create a balance between science and spirituality
- Leaders must put public interest above personal interest
- Less politicking and more thinking is needed
- Wealth of the nation should be equally distributed, etc.

What the West Must do to Avoid Influx of Muslim Refugees:

- Don't create war in the Muslim World
- Stop interfering in the politics of the Islamic world
- Stop imposing Western values in Muslim countries
- Stop 'Confrontational Politics" and start an 'Engaging Politics' with the Muslim World
- 'Terror breeds terror'
- 'What goes around, comes around'
