Spoken and written words

 "Unlike in the case of verbal communication, prior to submitting a written work for publication authors have the opportunity to edit and revise it multiple times. They can revisit it again and again in order to enhance its content and polish its language. Once they submit their 'final' draft to a journal, editors and reviewers evaluate and assess its merit and suitability. If a manuscript is accepted, they help further revise, refine, and make it ready for production." "In the field of language and literature, as in many other disciplines, we academics largely deal in and with words. We speak words during instructional contact hours with students and explain to them human conditions — real or fictional — expressed in words and other symbols. We publish words that then help us meet the pressing demand to build academic credentials. Thus, we use both spoken and written words for learning as well as for knowledge creation and dissemination purposes."

Put maximum efforts and prepare a best possible draft > Share it with your friend-1 for their feedback/comments. > Work on their comments (you may accept or ignore their corrections/feedback) and then prepare a revised draft. >

Give the revised draft to your friend-2 for their inputs/comments. > Work on their comments (you may accept or ignore their corrections/feedback) and then prepare another revised draft. >

Read the finished product few more times to make it as flawless as possible, in-shaa-Allah.

At the end of your book review, you will need to mention the names of the two friends who will have read your work, including their email addresses and mobile numbers. You should not ask someone to read your work who has already read three book reviews of other ENGL4020 students.
