#### **Abstract**

Financial literacy is an important national issue and has become the main focus in many countries. Various reports have confirmed that a huge number of the world's population is lacking knowledge of finance. The increasing number of people with a low level of financial literacy reflects the effectiveness of their educational institution and impacts the well-being of the national economy in the country.
