



Kamal Hassan had passed on at the age of eighty, at the wee hour of 23rd February 2023, at Selayang Hospital, Selangor, Malaysia. HAMKA, or Haji Abdul Malik Karim Amrullah was born on 17th February 1908 in Agam, West Sumatra, and died on 24th July 1981 at the age of seventy-three. He was laid to rest at Tanah Kusir public cemetary in Jakarta, Indonesia.
