



## A PEEK INTO THE MIND OF A TRUE MURABBI

Professor Emeritus Tan Sri Dr. M. Kamal Hassan (Allāh yarhamuhu) needed no introduction among many of the older generations of leaders, academics, scholars and students of the Muslim world. He was the third Rector of the International Islamic University Malaysia from 1998 to 2006, who contributed immensely to the University for 40 years. For most of us, he was an academic and scholar par excellence, an effective leader, a gentle and caring father figure and big brother, an outstanding pillar, and an internationally renowned teacher and thinker. He was known to walk the talk, always firmly unapologetic in his views on fundamental matters, yet flexible when considering circumstances. A champion of the Ummatic agenda of Islamisation or Islamicisation.

A towering figure, yet selfless and distinctively overflowing with humility. A multiple awards winner and an honourable multiple awards-decliner, never did he ever come near to self-promotion. He was ever watchful of his words, actions and the purity of his heart. His knowledge and experiences were vast, yet he always humbled himself down to reach his students and mad'ū-indeed an excellent example of a true Islamic scholar and murabbī.
