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FOREWORD FROM THE AUTHOR

All praise to Allah SWT for giving us the opportunity to complete this TARTĪL book. This book is written for TILAWAH subjects under the Tilawah Division, Centre For Languages And Pre-University Academic Development (CELPAD), International Islamic University Malaysia (IIUM).

This book will guide students through a step-by-step learning process that contains materials for the three levels of Tilawah courses offered by CELPAD which are TQTD 1001, TQTD 1002 and TQTD 2002. Students using this book must be guided by a teacher during the learning process in line with the traditional way of learning the Quran which is *TALAQQI*. *TALAQQI* refers to students reciting the book in the presence of a teacher so as to allow the teacher to monitor their recitation in every learning session.

In the process of writing this book, we ensured only words that exist in the Quran were used as examples. This is to familiarise students with Quranic words well before they are able to recite the Quran in the proper way with Tajwīd rules.

The Quranic recitation used in this book is based on Ḥafs ‘An Āṣim according to al-Shāṭibiyyah method which is commonly used in Malaysia. This book also presents Quranic words in its original script which is called RASM UTHMĀNĪ (Uthmānī script). This script is the special way that the Quran has been written which differs from the normal Arabic writing in some letters and symbols.

At the end of every level of this book, we put some selected Surahs from the Quran that students have to memorise based on the requirements of the respective courses. This is to ease the process of learning and make it more convenient for both students and teachers as they will not be required to open the Mushaf itself.

May Allah SWT bless us for the effort of writing this book. We hope that this book will help students to recite the Quran better in line with the vision and mission of the university.
