ABSTRACT

This chapter examines business ethical management system from the Islamic point of view, specifically Tawheedic perspective. It explains the meaning of Tawheed in Islam which is the Unity of God. It also relates the management to the Islamic leadership in an organization which explains three element of a leader should have which are humility, responsibility and accountability.
