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25. TIME OF ACCESS AT SCHOOL RESOURCE CENTRE

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ABSTRACT

Students who visited the school resource centre have their own preferred time when accessing the materials. The findings showed that about seventy percent of the students most of them accessed the school resource centre during the NILAM programs and during recess time Only a small number of students, fifteen percent of them, bothered to visit the school resource centre after school hour. Students declined to use the available Online Public Accesss Catalogue (OPAC) in the school resource center to search for their publication, but instead they browsed from one shelf to another to access the needed publications.

25.1 INTRODUCTION

Although the SRC were open most of school hours, not all students visit and access the school resource centre at the same time or most of the opening hour's period. We investigated students' inclination time of accessing the SRC using survey. Our respondents consisted of 115 students from school. Our analysis showed that the highest percentage, 44.6% accessed during NILAM program. followed by 24.8% have accessed during recess time, 15.1 % accessed after school hour and 12.4% or 32 respondents have accessed during
