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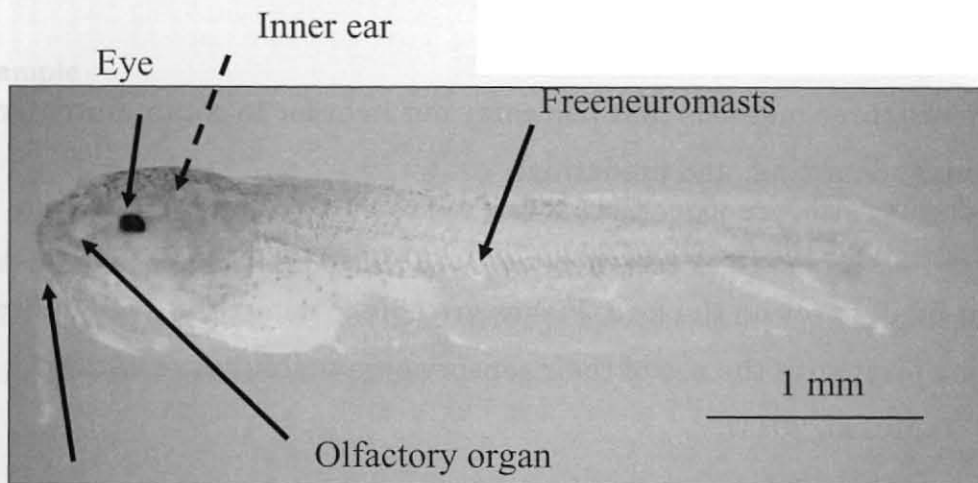
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Introduction

Fish have several sensory organs, which are the eyes, lateral lines, olfactory organs, inner ears and taste buds.
