





PS01. Clinical Practice Guidelines in Primary Care



What is the Meaning of Clinical Practice Guidelines in Primary Care and How do We Make Clinical Guidelines Work for Family Doctors?

Michael Kidd (Flinders University, Australia)

Michael is the president-elect of Wonca. He is a general practitioner and the Dean of the Faculty of Health Sciences at Flinders University in Australia. He is a past president of the Royal Australian College of General Practitioners and chairs the Australian Government's Advisory Committee on Blood Borne Viruses and Sexually Transmissible Infections.

[Overview]

As family doctors we need reliable trusted information to support our decision making so that we provide our patients with the best possible clinical care and advice. Clinical practice guidelines can be an important source of advice for family doctors. This presentation will discuss the meaning of clinical practice guidelines in primary care, how we can make guidelines work for family doctors, and how we might cope with a huge number of guidelines coming at us from different directions.



What are Challenges to Develop and Implement Clinical Practice Guidelines in Korea?

Hyeong Sik Ahn (Korea University College of Medicine, Korea)

Hyeong Sik Ahn is a health service researcher. He has been working on evidence based medicine and is a leader on a variety projects for clinical practice guidelines and systematic review. He totally published 50 papers on international and Korean refereed journals, which have been cited over 400 times, and is the author of six chapters of five books. He is the convener of 8th Guidelines International Network which was held in Seoul in 2011.

[Overview]

In Korea, physicians, health care professionals, and policy makers have taken increasing interest in clinical practice guidelines, sparking discussions within the healthcare community. While many guidelines have been developed through professional academic organizations recently, there are still concerns and issues in developing and implementing these guidelines. It's the challenges to Develop and Implement Clinical Practice Guidelines in Korea.

PS02. Contribution of Family Doctors to the Community



A World of Family Doctors: Improving Health, Serving Communities

Richard Roberts (University of Wisconsin, USA)

Dr. Roberts is a professor in the Department of Family Medicine at the University of Wisconsin School of Medicine & Public Health in Madison. As a family physician and attorney, Dr. Roberts serves as President of the World Organization of Family Doctors (Wonca). Professor Roberts has been involved extensively in primary care redesign around the world.

[Overview]

Upon completion of the session, the participant will be able to:

1. Describe why people do better when their health care is centered in a relationship with a family doctor.

2. Define the 4 Ps of the complete family doctor, who bridges individual and community health.

3. Discuss the 2 most important aims and assets of primary health care.

This session will describe some of the innovations developed to advance primary health care and will look far into the future of health care.



The Role of Primary Care Physician in Reducing Health Inequities

Chang-yup Kim (The Korean Society for Equity in Health, Seoul National University, Korea)

Chang-yup KIM is a professor of health policy at the School of Public Health, Seoul National University. His current research activities include health and social policy, equity and justice in health, health reform, and global health. As an extension of academic interest, he has been the founding president of the Korean Society for Equity in Health since October 2003.

[Overview]

Countries take various positions on recognizing and publicizing equity issues, including in the health sector. However, the current socioeconomic mainstream in many countries both expedites health disparities and diminishes possible countermeasures to ameliorate them. Basic characteristics of health inequity form a vicious cycle with other factors such as income, education, occupation, and health behavior.

Hypertension Management in Primary Care

Duk-hyun Kang (Asan Medical Center, University of Ulsan College of Medicine, Korea)

Duk-hyun Kang, M.D. PhD. degree from Seoul National University. Since 2007, He has served as a Professor of Division of Cardiology, Asan Medical Center, University of Ulsan. Dr. Kang is a renowned cardiologist who published 7 clinical research papers in Circulation and received clinical research award in 2002 and 2007.

[Overview]

Hypertension is a major risk factor for stroke, myocardial infarction, renal failure, congestive heart failure and atherosclerosis. Treatment of hypertension helps reduce the risk of cardiovascular disease and stroke, but the number of people with uncontrolled hypertension continues to be increasing, despite very effective antihypertensive therapy. Here, the strategies required for control of hypertension in the primary care will be discussed.



Diabetes Management in Primary Care


Kohjiro Ueki (Graduate School of Medicine, University of Tokyo, Japan)

Dr. Kohjiro Ueki as an associate professor and the director of Department of Diabetes and Metabolic Disease, the University of Tokyo. He has dedicated to research on diabetes and metabolic disease and served as an instructor in medicine, Harvard Medical School and Cellular and Molecular Physiology, Joslin Diabetes Center over years. In 2012, Japan Society of Experimental Diabetes and Obesity honored him with Research Award.

[Overview]

A rapid increase in the prevalence of diabetes is a growing and threatening health issue in Asian countries as well as other regions. Hypoglycemia, hyperinsulinemia and body weight gain frequently associated with anti-hyperglycemic therapy could increase cardiovascular events and mortality especially for the patients with long history of diabetes and advanced atherosclerosis. It is important for the primary care physicians to identify the individuals with prediabetesand mild diabetes by appropriate screening methods.

Dyslipidemia Management in Primary Care

Peter J Lin (Canadian Heart Research Center, Canada)

Dr. Lin trained in family medicine and has served as the medical director at the University of Toronto's Health and Wellness Centre at Scarborough for seven years. Currently, he is also the Director of Primary Care Initiatives at the Canadian Heart Research Centre. He is also on the national radio station CBC in Canada. Dr. Lin also received a teaching award from the College of Family Physicians in 2011.

[Overview]

Cardiovascular disease has been the number one killer of patients in the developed countries and is increase in the developing world at an alarming rate. The goal is to eradicate this disease world wide. As we understand the impact of statin therapy, we realize the groups of patients that can be helped is expanding. Recently, aggressive statin therapy has been found to be helpful in women, impaired fasting glucose patients , and even in early renal disease patients. The goal is the limit the impact of atherosclerosis on all our patients with aggressive and earlier treatment with statin therapies. The Canadian Lipid guidelines will be reviewed.



Update on the Role of Aspirin in Primary Prevention of CVD Events

J. Michael Gaziano (Brigham and Women's Hospital, Harvard Medical School, USA)

Dr. Gaziano is a Professor of Medicine at Harvard Medical School in Boston, MA. He is a cardiologist and chronic disease epidemiologist at both Brigham and Women's Hospital and VA Boston Medical Center in Boston. He is an internationally recognized epidemiologist whose research interests include the epidemiology of chronic diseases in aging populations, with a particular interest in coronary artery disease, stroke and the adverse impact of vascular disease on other organ systems. Dr. Gaziano oversees several fellowship programs and teaches advanced epidemiology at the Harvard School of Public Health. He has published over 400 journal articles, reviews, book chapters and books. He also serves as a contributing editor for the Journal of the American Medical Association.

[Overview]

The benefits of aspirin in the primary and secondary prevention of cardiovascular disease (CVD) have been conclusively demonstrated. Patients with documented CVD should be on aspirin at a dose of at least 75 mg per day unless clearly contraindicated. In primary prevention, the use of aspirin for prevention must take into account the individual's long-term risk of subsequent cardiovascular disease.

Wonca Asia Pacific Region: Challenges and Opportunities

Donald K.T. Li (Hong Kong College of Family Physicians, Hong Kong)

Dr. Li is a specialist in family medicine in private practice, and proprietor of family medicine practice in Hong Kong. He is the president of the World Organization of Family Doctors (Wonca) Asia Pacific Region, Censor of the Hong Kong College of Family Physicians. Throughout his career, he has been a leading expert and ardent advocate in promoting better primary care and family health in Hong Kong and internationally.

[Overview]

The Wonca Asia Pacific Region remains very active with annual regional meetings, research meetings as well as healthcare related forums on structure, under-development of preventive care, low health awareness among users and improvement of quality of care. These meetings help to influence stakeholders which include peers, patients, administrators and politicians alike and are tools to lobby more governments and administrations in the region to support primary care and family medicine by decree.



Future Perspective of Family Medicine in Asia Pacific Region

Bong Yul Huh (Center for Cancer Prevention and Detection, National Cancer Center, Korea)

Prof. Huh has played an instrumental role to establish the family medicine in Korea. He contributed to the successful foundation of 1st family medicine program at Seoul National University Hospital as chairman of Department of FM. He has produced many educators and leaders of FM to supply the nation. He devoted himself to the settlement of FM in Korea. He served Wonca for many years as a council member. He held successfully 1997 Seoul Wonca APR conference as Organizing Chairman.

[Overview]

The need for qualified primary care (Family Medicine) is expected to increase in the coming future. The growth of FM in this region is still not sufficient to cover the need. More targeted strategy will be needed to achieve this goal. Using Diffusion of Innovation Curve to visualize the roadmap of FM development will be helpful to solve this problem. Glocal strategy , locally with phased approach of the developmental stage and globally with intensified regional collaboration will be urgently recommended.
