Henrik Tjernberg, Chairman of Micro Systemation (MSAB) - the global leader in forensic technology.

Henrik Tjernberg was born 1960 in the north of Sweden and studied Engineering Physics at the Royal Institute of Technology in Stockholm.

In 1985 he became development manager at Micro Systemation AB, where he a year later became president and CEO. During the 90s Micro Systemation developed telecommunications software and in conjunction with its IPO in 1999 launched SoftGSM, the first ever entirely software-based GSM modem.

Henrik Tjernberg was elected chairman 2002 and the company started the development of XRY, which is now the world's leading product for forensic analysis of mobile devices, mainly mobile phones.
