THIRTY-FOUR scholars and academicians from prominent Islamic universities took part in an international seminar yesterday that focused on the latest practices related to teaching and learning language skills.

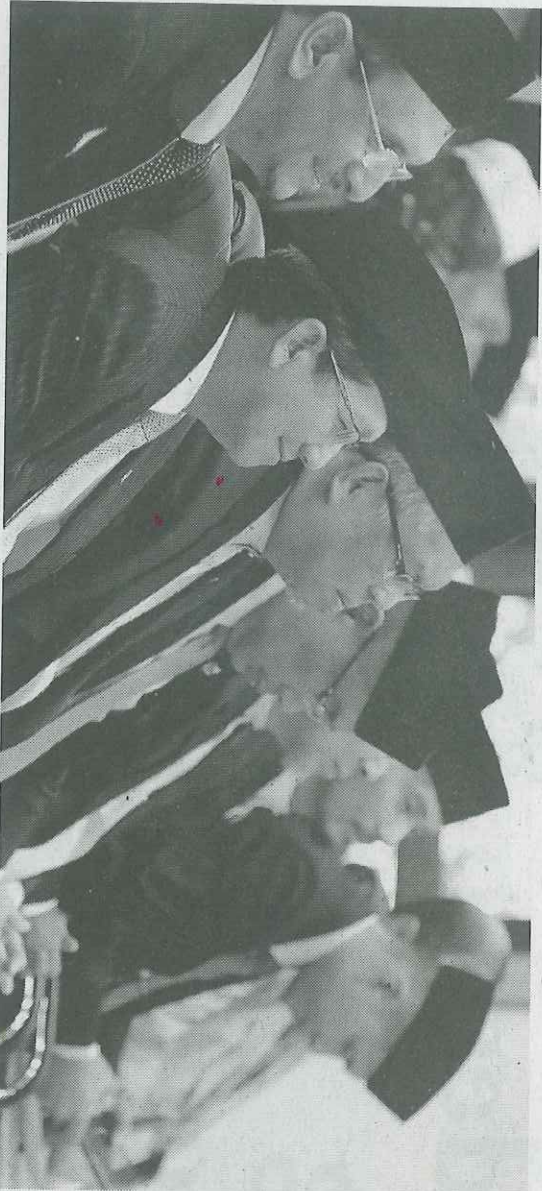
Held at Universiti Islam Sultan Sharif Ali (UNISSA), the seminar was organised by its Centre for Promotion of Knowledge and Language Learning (PPKB) in an effort to support its development.
