7.3 Exposure of the Programme to Current General Knowledge and Development

Of the 4092 respondents 92.8% (n=3799) agreed that the courses they studied at IIUM adequately exposed them to current general knowledge and development. Only 7.2% were in view that the programmes did not adequately expose them to current general knowledge and development (Table 7.3).

7.4 Teaching and Learning System-Exam Oriented

Table 7.4 indicates that 81.3% (n=3342) of IIUM graduates perceived that teaching and learning system of IIUM was exam-oriented. However, about 771 out of 3853 graduates had the opposite perception (18.7%).

7.5 Evaluation System-Exam Oriented
