


HOW TO GET TO HOTEL PUTRA, KUALA LUMPUR?


For international participants:

You could reach Malaysia through Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA), Kuala Lumpur International Airport 2, (KLIA2) or Subang International Airport, and then hire a limousine or a taxi from KLIA to Hotel Putra, Jalan Tun Razak, Kuala Lumpur for approximately 70 kilometres. Normal charge for each taxi is about MYR100. Additional charge might be applied if you travel after midnight.




