KIRKHS-IIIT Islamisation Conference In conjunction with IIUM World Prosumer Convention 2017 7-8 August 2017

1.0 Introduction

Islamisation of Knowledge (IOK) is the core principle and the founding philosophy that guides research, learning and teaching activities at the International Islamic University Malaysia (IIUM). The propagation of knowledge at IIUM is guided by the principle of Tawhid that aims towards the recognition of Allah as the Absolute Creator and Master of mankind. To this end research activities at IIUM have always focused on Islamisation of knowledge laying emphasis on the publication of research books, journal articles, textbooks and related activities. At the centre of the University's Islamisation efforts is the Kulliyah of Islamic Revealed Knowledge and Human Sciences (KIRKHS) that brings together various academic departments representing a wide range of disciplines both from the Religious and Human Sciences. The main aim of the Kulliyah is to bring together these various disciplines and facilitate the integration of Islamic revealed knowledge and human science based on the fundamental principle of Tawhid. To this end the KIRKHS works in collaboration with various national and international research institutes to achieve mutual objectives.

In line with the above, we are pleased to announce that in conjunction with the IIUM PROVEST Week 2017, the Kulliyah of Islamic Revealed Knowledge and Human Sciences (KIRKHS) in collaboration with the International Institute of Islamic Thought (IIIT) will be organising a two day conference on Islamisation and Integration of Knowledge from the 7th to 8th of August 2017. The conference will bring together various scholars and researchers involved in Islamisation research to share their research findings and highlight current projects and activities. The conference will be hosted by the KIRKHS at IIUM's main Campus in Gombak, Kuala Lumpur.

2.0 Objectives

- a. To trace the development of the concepts of "method" and "methodology" in both Islamic thought and Western thought, and to identify the critical junctures in this development and the ways in which such development has been manifested in scientific and epistemological production and cultural advancement.
- b. To draw attention to the importance of research into methodological issues, and the central place occupied by methodology in academic research in the various fields of human knowledge, including the Islamic legal sciences, the humanities, the social sciences, and the natural and applied sciences.

- c. To identify the sources and tools of Islamic methodology and their unique characteristics, and to demonstrate the integrative and complementary relationship between methodological sources, methodological tools, and between the sources and the tools of methodology.
- d. To share research findings and highlight current projects and activities within the Kuliyyah and beyond.

3.0 Expected Outcomes

- a. Better understanding of the concept of Islamic epistemology and implementation of Islamic research methodologies in various fields.
- b. Better coordination and cooperation between researchers, the Kuliyyah and IIIT in implementing research, publication and other relevant activities.
- c. Published proceedings of proposal papers for the IRKHS-IIIT Textbook Project.
