Trauma is among the commonest presentations at the emergency room being the third highest mortality (28.6 per cent) after coronary heart disease and septicaemia. The economic loss resulting from trauma has increased every year at the average rate of 9.7 per cent since the past three decades. In order to equip the young doctors with vast knowledge and experience in this area, the Ministry of Health has introduced additional posting in the Anesthesiology and Critical Care as well as the Accident and Emergency departments during housemanship training to ensure better management at the frontline.
