






#### Subject coverage in Scopus







- CONVERT YOUR PRESENTATION DURING VIVA INTO A CONFERENCE PAPER, AND THEN ARTICLE.
- DETERMINE THE AREA OF WRITING, REVIEW OF LITERATURE OR CASE STUDY.
- SELECT THE CONTENT AND COMPRESS INTO AN ARTICLE.
- REFER TO THE SUBMISSION GUIDELINES OF A JOURNAL.
- PREPARE YOUR FIRST DRAFT OF ARTICLE.
- CONSULT YOUR SUPERVISOR FOR FURTHER IMPROVEMENT.
- SEND YOUR ARTICLE TO THE CHIEF EDITOR THROUGH EMAIL OR OJS.
- WAIT FOR FEEDBACK, REVIEWER'S COMMENTS, DOING CORRECTIONS AND FINAL SUBMISSION.
