Malaysia 's 13th general election (henceforth, GE13) in 2013 was the final election where the longest-serving elected government in the world, Barisan Nasional (BN), regained power, before it was ousted after over six decades of authoritarian rule in 2018. Focusing on editorial journalistic genres in four paid-for Malay -language newspapers, I illustrate the typical politics of fear that characterises much of Malaysian right-wing rhetoric-the ways in which racial and religion issues are provoked.
