
EXPLORING THE PERCEPTION OF RELIGIOUS PLURALISM AMONG PUBLIC UNIVERSITY'S STUDENTS

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## Introduction

- Religious pluralism is a philosophy that claims all religions are aiming for the same Truth, but it advocates for different paths to the same Truth based on one's different religio-culturalpolitical context.
- Religious pluralism is contradicting to Islam.
- In addition, this philosophy has been declared as deviated from Islam by JAKIM and the Government of Selangor gazette on 31<sup>st</sup> July 2014.

# Objective

- They are expected to be aware of contemporary discourses that are contradicting to Islam.
- The students are expected to become the source of reference for the public not only in their area of specialization but also on issues related to Islam and in this case, religious pluralism is without exception.
- Thus, this study explores the perception of an Islamic public university's students to the philosophy of religious pluralism and its debates.

### Method

- Focus group discussion (FGD)
- 6 FGDs consisted of 45 students
- Convenient sampling techniques
- The questions asked:
  - 1. Do you know the meaning of religious pluralism?
    - If yes, can you please define the meaning?
    - If no, why do you think you have no clue on its meaning?
  - 2. Are you aware of the debate on religious pluralism in Malaysia; and the individuals/scholars who are in support of/reject religious pluralism?

## Method

- The data was transcribed and analyzed thematically:
  - (1) familiarizing the data
  - (2) coding
  - (3) searching the themes
  - (4) reviewing the themes
  - (5) defining and naming the themes
  - (6) writing up the report
