Abstract

IIUMToday is the official campus news portal for the International Islamic University Malaysia (IIUM) operated by students under the supervision of the Department of Communication, faculty of human sciences. IIUMToday aims to train students in news reporting and various practical aspects of journalism. The portal has been established on 1 May 2014, and this paper sets out to study its development. Therefore, the objectives of this paper are: (1) to examine the impact of IIUMToday in preparing students for their future in the industry; (2) to study the importance of campus journalism in developing students' skills. Both of the objectives will be explored by employing a qualitative approach. The methodology of this study comprises interviews with current and former IIUMToday members consisting of communication students, graduates and editorial board members. The findings of the study will center first upon the fruition of campus journalism among students; the positive impacts and upon the role of campus journalism in developing students' future career prospects.
