The invited speakers highlighted that despite the remarkable social, economic, and scientific advancements in the modern world, many people suffer from psychological disorders such as anxiety, depression, stress, and nihilism. This indicates that the true concept of man and his identity as portrayed in the world's major religions have been undermined. The alienation of the self from his spiritual original has plagued the entire humanity. As such, the webinar was viewed by many participants, Muslim and non-Muslims alike, as timely and crucial in reinstating God-consciousness and ethical awareness, which are prerequisites for the knowledge of peace and happiness. It is indeed a challenge that the current system of knowledge has undermined the spiritual dimension of the self and the relevance of its purity to the wellbeing of society and civilization.

Dr. Alizaman presented a critical analysis of (WHO) World Health Organization perspective on spirituality, religion, and personal beliefs as essential factors in the evaluation of the quality of life, thus, leading the entire discourse into the prominence of integration of knowledge as an important instrument for bridging the gap between conflicting cultural groups. In addition, Dr. Alizaman made a remarkable example of a true embodiment of unity within diversity by citing how racial harmony has been observed in Malaysia after her independence in 1957. Such meaning of social integration can be replicated

yet, despite this possibility, this shift is, and will continue to be, accompanied with some contradictions, tensions, and shortages. This article concludes by highlighting three points: the extent to which IIUM succeeded in producing professionally-trained versus Islamically-oriented graduates; the level of success IoK mainstreaming has had using the *Maqāṣidic* approach; and, finally, how the implementation of the IoK paradigm may be impeding pluralism. ❖ [Read in full here.](#)

4. Papers should not be more than 8000 words and should be typed set on Times New Roman, 12 font size, double line spacing in English or Traditional Arabic, 18 font size in Arabic language.
5. Assessment fee for Nigerian authors for each paper is ₦5,000 and publication fee for each accepted paper is ₦20,000.
6. The closing date for submission of papers for this edition is 30th December, 2021.
7. Submission for subsequent editions is open.
