THEME OF THE CONFERENCE

• Islamic Perspective on Leadership: A Framework for Practice in the Contemporary World

I have divided my presentation into 4 sections:

- There are two dimensions in this topic
 - Islamic Perspective and Leadership

What is Islam and its aim?

- We need to review our understanding of Islam
- Many people do not have authentic understanding of it
- Most of them have reduced it to the level of a religion like any other religion like Judaism and Christianity

What is Islam?(Continues)

- Although since the time of Sha Wali Allah Dehlwi to the Shaikh Yousuf Al-Qardawi, all scholars of Islamic revivalist tradition presented it as Din, the way of life.
- But this term Din is also corrupted and frequently used for religion or in a religious sense. In this way Islam as religion is confined to the personal and private aspects of life.
- It is misused for sectarian and selfish interests

What is Islam?(Continues)

- In spite of several reminders and even commitment to Islam as the way of life, it is still used as religion and remains as a theory.
- In society, community, state and government practically it is not accepted as the way of life.
- So, I would like to submit that Islam is not a religion in a limited sense as it is understood in the modern world.

What is Islam?(Continues)

- Based on the study of the texts of Islam the Quran and Sunnah I argue that it must be taken as the worldview, the way of life, source of culture and civilization which stands for the overall development of individual, society, government and state.
- Well-being of people and success here in this world and the next world is the main target of Islam.

Leadership and its Characteristics

- The issue of leadership and its characteristics need to be understood in the context of society, state, government, overall cultural and civilizational development.
- I feel this conference would help to comprehend the civilizational role of leadership in a comprehensive and holistic way
- It is clear from the perspective of Islam and civilizational development that the notion of leadership is comprehensive, holistic, moderate but dynamic and future oriented.
- It stands to serve the needs of people.

Leadership and its Characteristics(continues)

- A leadership has to think and plan for the success of people, community and society taking into consideration all aspects of life, physical, ethical, spiritual, moral, legal, and consequential.
- People and society must be developed by a committed leadership.

Leadership Prerequisites

- 1. A leader must have a Clear Vision and commitment to the Mission of Islam.
 - This requires clear understanding of the message of Islam to humanity: to understand the truth and reality of life and the world especially the purpose of life. Allah SWT as the Creator.
- 2. Clear Vision of Islamic life and Society
 - They are based on ethical, spiritual, moral and legal foundation. Nothing can be sacrificed for the sake of other.

3. Ijtihadic and Dynamic Qualities

- The second Caliph Umar said:
- Zaiyad Ibn Hudayr related: "Umar said to me, "Do you know what will destroy Islam?" When I said that I did not, he said, "It will be destroyed by the mistakes of scholars, the arguing of hypocrites using the Book, and government by leaders who are in error."
- This is further supported by the tradition of the Prophet Muhammad, peace be upon him, who is reported to have said, 'There are two classes in my ummah who, if they are right the ummah will be set right; and if they go wrong the ummah will go wrong: they are the rulers and the scholars.'

- 3.1. During the period of Rightly Guided Caliphs, the leader was the thinker and the thinker was the leader. The vision of Islam for him was a dominant factor and the zeal to make community, govt. and state Islamic.
- 3. 2. He was able to involve and engage the whole community in the process of development.

4. Clear empirical and rational approach

- All scientific and rational tools and techniques are practically applied. Leadership must be aware of it.
- He must be capable to see the current situation of the societies and plan for their development.
- A good leader must be capable to plan to produce the committed, dedicated, honest, hard-working, future-oriented and visionary human resources.
- Leaders themselves need to be creative and Ijtihadic

- 5. Leaders must encourage scientific, critical and creative thinking. Tawhid creates and develops all these qualities. Lack of Tawhid makes people imitators and mentally slaves.
- 6. A good leader must be able to reject every perspective that goes against Islamic worldview courageously and plan to develop everything based on Islamic perspective.
- 7. Leaders must be capable to encourage the scholars and intellectuals, experts and skilled specialists to develop Islamic models of modernization and development with the help of the proper and needful technology.

- 8. Leader must be capable to create among the members of the community an urge for a better life based on the worldview of Islam with clean environment, fair distribution of resources maintaining justice.
- 9. Leader must be capable to guarantee political stability, material development, economic growth and scientific and technological environment based on Islamic theories and models.

Concluding Remarks

- No Leader can achieve his goals and guarantees development, justice and happiness without bringing drastic and radical change in the existing system of education.
- A referendum can be held for the purpose of development of a new but Islamic educational system.
- Advancement in knowledge is the master key for all success.
- A leader must promote and encourage and also create an environment of creation of new knowledge.

Concluding Remarks(Continues)

- A STRONG POLITICAL WILL WITH THE SUPPORT OF ALL THE SECTIONS OF THE SOCIETY IS NEEDED TO GUARANTEE ISLAMIC MODEL OF DEVELOPMENT WHICH URRENTLY LACKS IN THE MUSLIM WORLD.
