1. Busy Family

**My parents were very busy
with work and gaining
money.**

**“They didn’t spend much time with me.
I stayed with a nanny from the day I was
born until I became 12 years old.”**

“They never asked how I was doing or how my day was. They **never praised me by telling me that I looked pretty.”**

**“As a girl, I wanted to be praised, especially
by my dad because he’s a man.**

2. Fighting Family

**“I didn’t stay with my parents; I had stayed with
my grandmother since I was very young, but
sometimes I would come home and see my
parents’ fighting.”**

“They *always argued* since I was 3 years old. Their relationship was never okay.”

“I saw my father beating my mum. Then he divorced her. When I was in Form 5, my mother had stage 4 cancer and finally passed away.”

“My father **never stayed with me since I was young. He got **married** to someone else and I stayed somewhere else.”**

3. Unaware Family

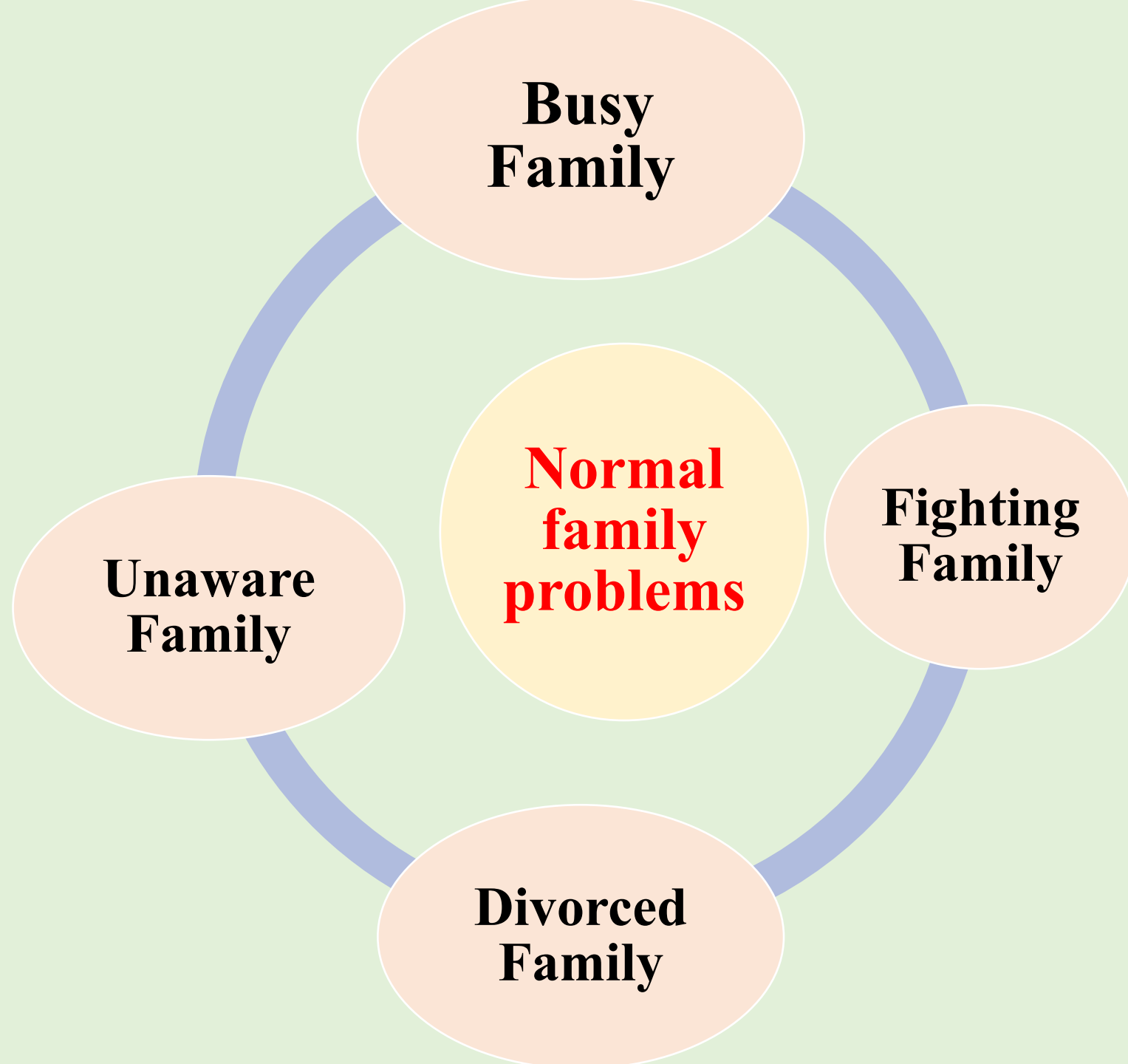
**“My father does not like daughters.

“He took care of my brothers.

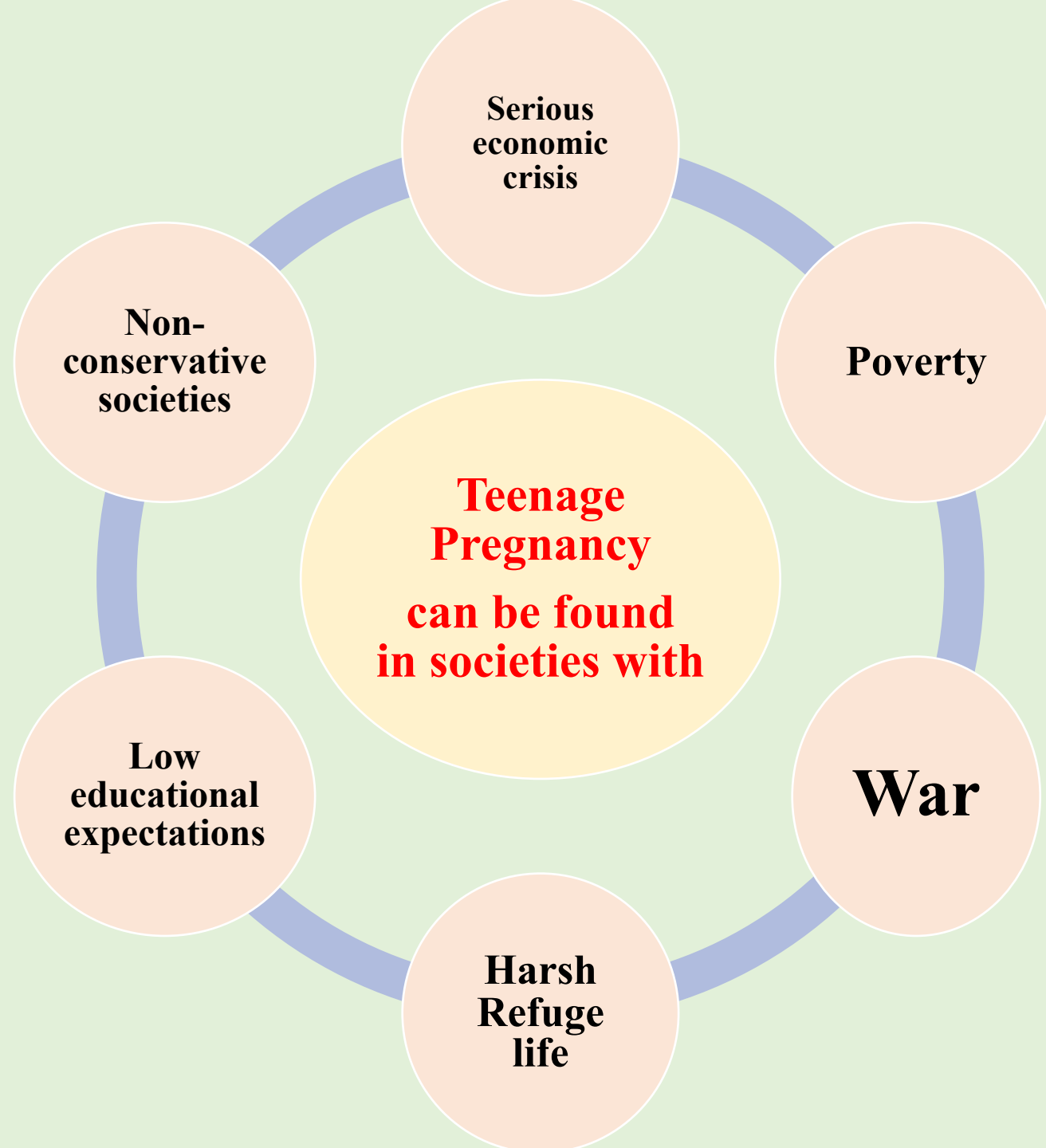
