APSA will cover the following expenses for you:

- 1. Accommodation in a single, non-smoking room with WiFi and daily buffet breakfast and lunch for the duration of the workshop (4 nights).
- 2. Roundtrip economy airfare to Bangkok (from your nearest international airport) arriving on July 20 and departing on July 24. Please note that you will be responsible for any fees or costs due to changes in dates or return cities.

## **COVID Guidance**

As of May 1, proof of vaccination is required for non-quarantine entry to Thailand. Fully vaccinated travelers will not need to test to enter. For more information, please refer to this website: https://tp.consular.go.th/.

Fully vaccinated travelers to Bangkok are still required to apply for the Thailand Pass. However, please hold off on applying for now and stay tuned for more guidance on when and how to apply for your Thailand Pass.

## Travel to Bangkok

You should plan to arrive in Bangkok on July 20 and depart on July 24. You will need to make your own visa arrangements, if necessary. Please check online or at the nearest Thai Embassy or Consulate for information regarding your visa. APSA will provide an invitation letter to present with your visa application or upon request at the airport.
