

- The aim of this narrative review
  - to summarise and synthesise articles written on the concept of 'Aql
  - to disseminate findings for further actions





What does the existing literature inform on the concept of 'aql?

## Methodology

Narrative literature review method to gain an insight of what have already been informed by existing research. A narrative literature review is a "systematic review that synthesizes the individual studies . . . systematically extracting, checking, and narratively summarizing information on their methods and results" (Petticrew & Roberts, 2008: 39).



## Methodology



This narrative review presented an overview of existing literature (Hodgkinson & Fords, 2014) on the concept of 'aql to inform decision making on the necessity of conducting further investigations on this topic.

# 5-Step Methodological Framework

- formulated a broad research question to guide literature search
  - searched the online databases using search terms that were inclusive enough to include relevant articles and exclusive enough to focus only the related topic
    - determined article selection criteria
      - reviewed and analysed the data
        - finally synthesized, summarized and report

### Search Terms Used-Both Malay and English Terms

- 'Aql AND Quran
- 'Aql AND Islam
- Reason AND Revelation

#### Search Result

- Initial search result=27000 articles
- Limited to first 400 articles
- Met selection criteria=130 articles
- Duplicates removed=127 articles
- Final relevant=61 articles


# Analysis and Conclusion Gap in Literature



No study was done to evaluate Muslims' understanding on the concept of 'aql according to Quran and Muslim scholars



No empirical studies
were conducted to
describe the present
Muslims' understanding
of role of 'aql and
thinking in Islam



The abundance of studies on the concept of 'aql have not impacted the Islamic Education curriculum developers since Quranic verses on 'aql and thinking were not in the curriculum



### Recommendations

- Further studies on the meaning of 'aql from the Quranic perspective. Most existing studies mentioned the Quranic verses on 'Aql but these verses were not unpacked to reveal the meaning of 'Aql and its functions
- Future research in examining the Muslims' understanding of the concept of 'aql and thinking in Islam to inform decision making in curriculum development
- Since 'aql is the core of human nature, therefore, it should be taught to Muslims at all levels of education
