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Addressing the Needs of Students with Learning Disabilities in Light of Hifz Al-A'ql

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Abstract Ensuring both inclusivity and equity remains a central challenge in education, particularly for a significant proportion of children worldwide with learning disabilities such as dyslexia, dyscalculia,
